

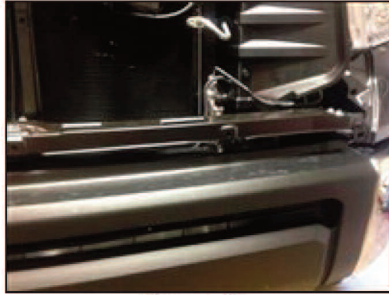

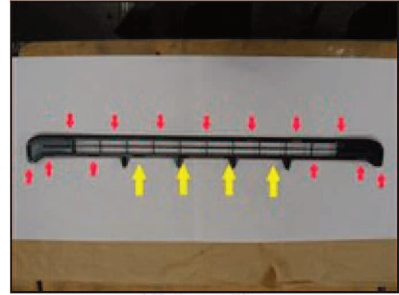

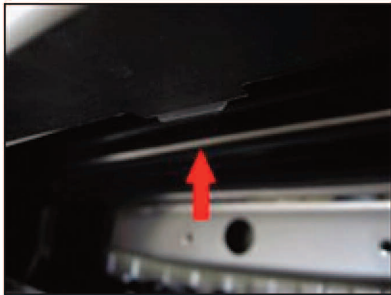
Picture #1:
Our project Toyota Tundra in need of a custom GrillCraft Grille.



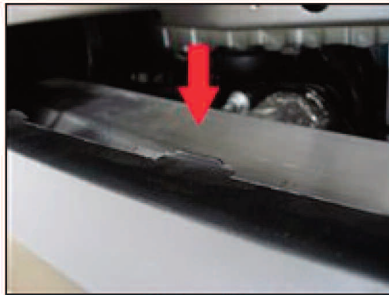
Picture #2:
To gain access to the back of the bumper you'll need to remove the Upper Grille. Follow those pertaining instructions on our Upper Grille Installation.



Picture #3:
To remove the factory lower grille, you'll need to release the clips in the bumper along its perimeter. While pushing the grille back towards the vehicle, release the red arrowed clips first and the yellow bottom clips last. This way you'll be able to remove the plastic insert without removing the bumper cover.



Picture #4:
The upper clips will need to be pushed upward in order to release.



Picture #5:
The lower clips will need to be pushed downward in order to release.



Picture #6:
Place your new mesh insert into the bumper opening and mark the locations of the tabs on the grille using a sharp scribe tool. Then using a 3/16" Drill bit, drill the (5) corresponding mounting holes.



Picture #7:
Locate the hardware included with the lower grille.



Picture #8:
Place the grille back into the bumper opening and mount with the included hardware.

Installation is now Complete! Our GrillCraft Upper & Lower Kit Shown In Black Powdercoat Finish.
